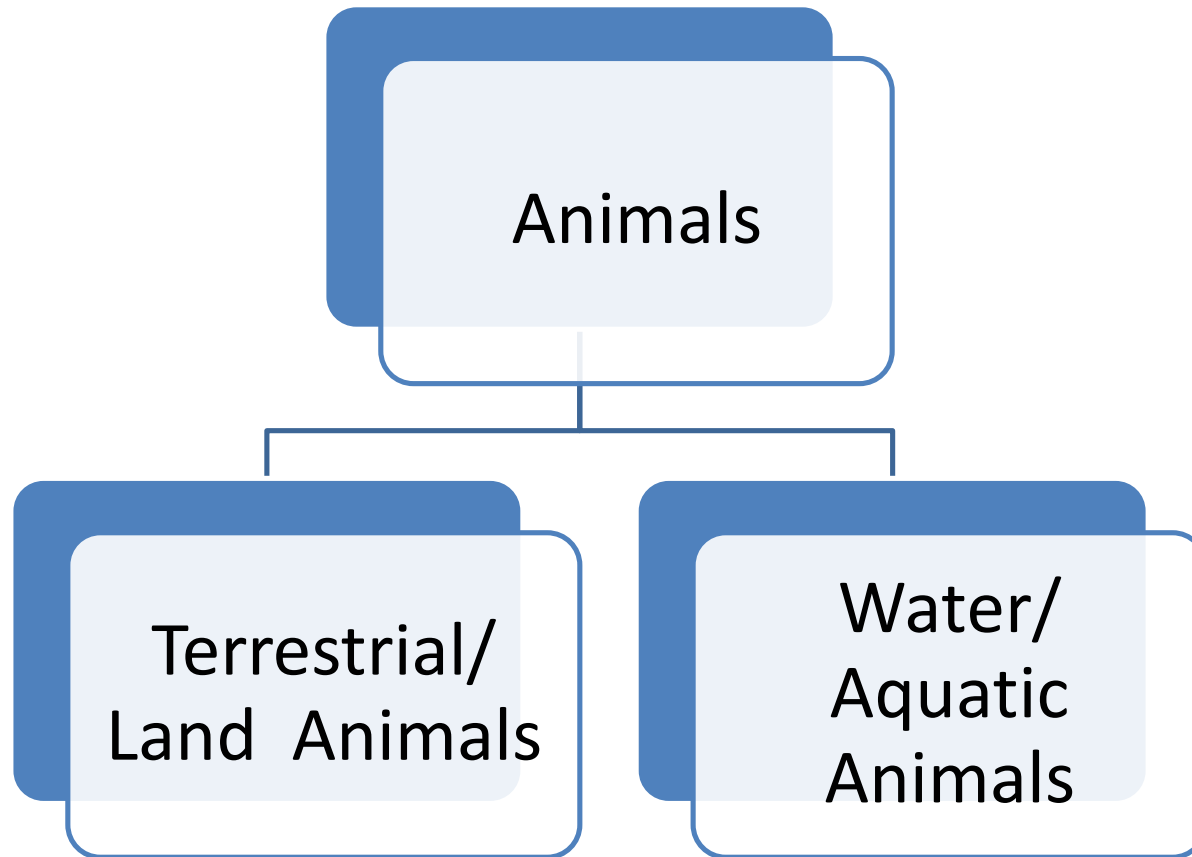

Animals Living in Deserts:

- They can store water and food in their bodies.
- They have padded feet that help them to walk on sand.

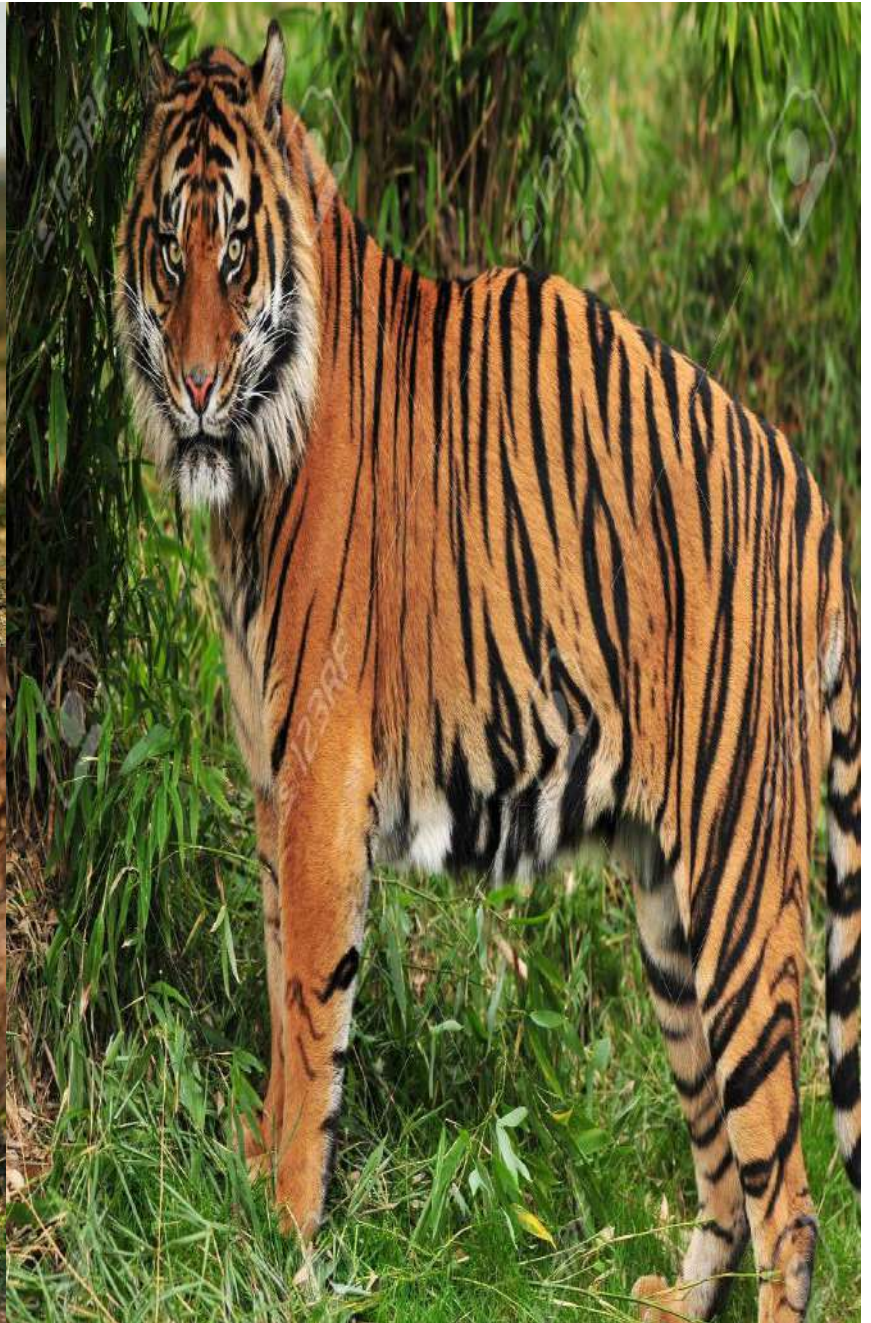

Animals Living in Forest:

- Forest provide shelter and food to many animals.
- The colour of the skin and body patterns of some of these animals, help them to merge with their surroundings and protect them from danger.





Animals living in cold Regions:

- These animals have thick fur to protect their bodies from cold.



Water Animals:

- A good part of earth is covered with water.
- Many animals live in ponds, lakes, rivers and oceans.
- Animals living in water are also called **aquatic animals**.
- These animals have fins for swimming and gills for breathing.

Frog:

- Animals like frogs and toads are land animals. However, they need water for laying their eggs.
- Frogs have webbed feet for swimming.
- They can also breathe in water.



Turtle:

- Turtles live in water for most of the time.
- They have flippers for swimming.
- They come to land when they have to lay eggs.



Crocodile:

- Crocodile is a land animal.
- It crawls on the ground.
- It lives near water and can also swim.

Dolphin:
