








MAN STARTED GROWING CROPS CLOSE TO RIVERS






HE STARTED LIVING IN HUTS NOW

EARLY MAN GOT THE IDEA OF WHEEL WHEN HE SAW A ROUND LOG OF WOOD ROLLING DOWN


